SCRIP Tips

Are you taking advantage of the SCRIP Program to help reduce your child's tuition costs? 100% of money you earn in rebates is deducted directly from your tuition bill. Check out these helpful tips!

1. Create an account at shopwithscrip.com and choose between ordering a physical gift card, reloading a card or ScripNow ecards.
2. Ecards can be used *immediately*, no need to wait for a physical card to arrive. Simply purchase your ScripNow card, go to your account "Dashboard" and click "View ScripNow" to access your card's code and PIN. (If using the mobile friendly site, myscripwallet.com, then your ecard will be located in the MyWallet tab)
3. Browse the hundreds of stores and restaurants available. Often the rebate percentage can beat rewards earned on credit cards. Example: Gymboree 13%, Old Navy 14%, Land's End 15%, Children's Place 12%, Maggiano's 11%, etc...
4. Myscripwallet.com can now be added to your cellphone homescreen for quick access to their website. It makes buying and using ScripNow ecards even easier for when you're out and about.
