



Parent Code of Conduct

1. Community Expectations

- **Model Catholic Values:** Demonstrate kindness, patience, and empathy in all interactions.
 - **Promote a Positive Atmosphere:** Avoid gossip, negativity, or conversations that undermine the school, staff, or other families. Concerns should be addressed respectfully and privately with appropriate staff.
 - **Support School Mission:** Encourage your child(ren) to live the values of respect, responsibility, and faith taught at Guardian Angels.
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2. Parking Lot & Arrival/Dismissal Conduct

- **Drive with Care:** Maintain slow speeds and remain alert to children and pedestrians at all times.
 - **Follow Procedures:** Adhere to designated drop-off/pick-up routes and staff directions to ensure safety and efficiency.
 - **Be Courteous:** Display patience and kindness toward staff, volunteers, and other families during busy times.
 - **No Gossip:** The parking lot is not a place for gossip or negative discussions about students, families, or staff.
 - **Be Aware:** Watch carefully for children crossing and follow all safety guidelines.
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3. Respect for School Staff & Community

- **Communicate Respectfully:** Treat all teachers, staff, and volunteers with courtesy and dignity at all times.
 - **Address Concerns Appropriately:** Schedule meetings or send emails to discuss concerns. Do not confront staff in front of children or during instructional times.
 - **Support Decisions:** Understand that teacher and administrative decisions are made with students' best interests in mind.
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4. Volunteering Expectations

Volunteers are essential to the success of our school. To ensure a safe and faith-filled environment:

- **Be Present & Engaged:** Cell phones must be silenced and put away while volunteering. Your focus should be on the children and the task at hand.
- **Model Guardian Angels Values:** Support and enforce school rules and behavior expectations. Address students respectfully and redirect behavior when necessary.

- **Maintain Confidentiality:** Respect the privacy of students and staff; do not share classroom or student information outside of school.
 - **Follow Staff Direction:** Work under the guidance of teachers and administrators, respecting their expertise and classroom policies.
 - **Be a Positive Role Model:** Demonstrate kindness, patience, and humility at all times.
 - **No Siblings on Field Trips:** For safety and supervision purposes, chaperones may not bring other children or siblings when volunteering on field trips. Chaperones must be fully available to supervise their assigned group of students.
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5. Consequences for Breach of Code

Failure to uphold this code of conduct may result in:

- A meeting with the administration.
 - Restricted or revoked volunteer privileges.
 - Other actions deemed necessary to maintain a positive, Catholic school environment.
