- 7. Event Committee Reports (President)
- Fall Family Bingo (9/19) (Rhonda Glasgow/Sheila Delo) Rhonda- event went well, we switched things around a bit (food and prizes). We will need to rethink prizes/gift cards. Most showed up (168/180 registered)

Bagels before the Bell (9/25 and 9/26) (Tanya Gasso/Emily Hoang) Event went well, probably will do 1 day instead of 2 days, we went over budget but Tanya donated, good for our first time.

Jog-a-Thon (10/3) (Asia Viers/Cindy O'Brien) Exceeded our goal by 13K, and had 6K in sponsorships. We had a DJ this year and that was a fun add. (Encounter Event Services)

Mom-2-Mom Sale (10/18) (Mandy Starski/Tammy Schick) Did not sell out, it was light on sellers and shoppers possibly because it was later in the year. Exceeded our target for fundraiser.

Considering moving to the spring and need more signage for advertising.

Trunk or Treat (10/24) (Heather Hoff/Lena Hermiz/Rachael Miller) Successful event, food trucks were new and that was well received, donations for candy worked out well and were able to share that with St. Nicholas day and All Saints Day Party. Plan to do food trucks and utilize the gym again. All Saints Day party (11/1) (Dorothy Ursaki/Lauren Bukowski) Largest event, 160 RSVP, we capped the event, then only had 120 attendees. We could have accommodated a few more families. We are going to do things a little different next year for advertising. Had pizza, salad and pasta salad.

- ★ Recommendation from parent: priority for 7th grade parents for next year's event.

 All School Skate Party (11/7) (Kim Kohatsu/Rlan Landingin) Went well, this is our 2nd event. We had 104 people attend. It was a smaller event, (last time we had 176 people at the event). We think it is due to the 4 day weekend. We didn't receive any complaints so that was good.

- **GAP Pizza Lunch(11/25)** (Veronica Reilly/Jenny Krysiak) We are going to split the lunch this year k-3 for 11:30 noon and then rest for the noon-12:30.
