**Meeting Agenda and Notes**

1. Call to order (President) **7:06 PM**
2. Opening prayer (Principal) Mrs. VanDusen, Cristin shared we will start including prayer intentions after our opening prayer.
3. Introductions (President)
4. Principal's Report (Principal) Received a large grant from the state of MI for safety, some of those items will be put in place in February. This will include an AI overlay for our cameras, this will pick up anything we ask it to, including specific faces, metal, etc. We also have been taking measurements for the windows and a quote is coming in to add a security layer. More will be shared in an upcoming communication from Mrs. VanDusen. The founder of the AI company will host a parent session to explain the technology. For the auction, we definitely need new pre-school furniture and we need some new kitchen equipment so we will use paddle up and other funds raised for. Because of the grant for safety we will be able to focus our auction dollars towards school improvements.

Dorothy Ursaki brought up the kids being outside at recess and safety out there. There is discussion around having a camera out on the playground, however, electrical needs to be run to the playground for this. We have our lunch staff and Fr. Tony and I have talked about adding more staff/volunteers for recess.

Lauren Bukowski - brought up the banner on the fencing. She had concerns about it blocking people's view and people hiding behind it. Mrs. Van Dusen indicated they are no longer going to install the banner.

5. Vice President's Report (Vice President) An additional new thing we are doing this year is we are incorporating pre-school more and more into our environment: we will buying pre-school teachers lunch for their conferences.
6. Treasurer's Report (Treasurer) Not much to report since November since we haven't had any large events. The big upcoming event is the Auction. Our contract with the venue is for 200 people, so far we have a little over half of our sales needed to cover our costs. Early bird pricing is available until Jan 31. Jogathon is closed and we came in 13K above our goal. The salmon project is live and going, everything was purchased and the fish are thriving so far. Keep the fish in your prayers.

Cindy O'Brien - Asked if Bingo night had any revenue, Miriam reminded that Bingo is not a fundraiser, it is a social event, so we don't budget for any revenue for that event.

A question about Santa shop - we made about \$1000 in revenue and were about \$250 short of our goal. We did renew the contract for next year, so we will get a 5% discount for next year.

We got a new invoice for IXL and we spent \$3K more than we had planned for. We spent \$13K on licenses. Dorothy asked if we could reconsider IXL and go back to paper homework? Mrs. VanDusen mentioned it is being considered and changes are coming. The Academy went to all paper and pencil for math, so it will be a gradual process.

## 7. Event Committee Reports (President)

- **GAP Pizza Lunch(11/25) (Veronica Reilly/Jenny Krysiak)** Jenny - went well. Hungry Howies gave us a really good deal. We split up K-3 and 4-8 and did recess and lunch in opposite groups. We incorporated extra salads. Next year we probably don't need as long of a volunteer window. Thinking about next year how we incorporate options for kids that don't like pizza. The event came in under budget by \$400. Jenny will chair again next year.
- **Giving Tuesday Campaign (12/2) (Miriam Gomez)** We received 2 donations for giving Tuesday for \$50 each so we got \$100. If there are other ideas, we are interested in hearing. Maybe we could do a dress down day for a couple dollars?

Shopping was heavy on Monday and Tuesday, but quiet later in the week; we will look to spread out the schedule over the week. If you have any suggestions please reach out.
- **St. Nicholas Day (12/5) (Emily Hoang/Veronica Korkis)** No report, confirmed they stayed under budget. May need a slight increase for next year.
- **PreK Cookies after Caroling (12/19) (Sarah Barberio/Nicole Case)** No report, Mrs. VanDusen shared that the tables were over at Foley, so we had to move the event to the cafeteria. Mrs. Barberio made all the cookies by hand. Positive feedback from parents.
- **Winter Family BINGO (1/23) (Rhonda Glasgow/Sheila Delo)** Good turnout even though we didn't have school. We had a few no shows. Ms. Rhonda did a good job with the food. We did run out of Bingo cards and cookies and prizes are depleted, so we need to restock fully for Spring. Sheila and Rhonda will chair again next year.
