Due to the Covid-19 virus precautions, it is with sadness that we are writing to let you know we are postponing our 2020 Children in Bloom Auction.

Raffle Update:

We are still moving forward with our raffle. Good news!

We decided to implement a new change. Every family who sells \$100 in tickets, regardless of the day they turned them in, will still receive their NUT card(s). We will also maintain the tuition credit for sales over \$100. The deadline for turning in ALL money and remaining tickets will be April 20th, 2020 by noon.

The raffle sales opportunities at Alliance Catholic Credit Union and Knights of Columbus Fish Fry have all been **cancelled**.

Families will still be allowed to obtain additional raffle tickets. The office has agreed to send them home with the classroom materials that are being prepared for families to be picked up Monday the 23rd.
