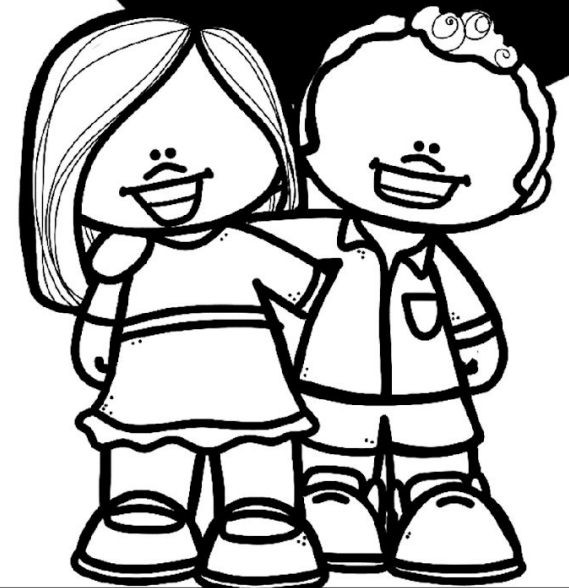

TEXTBOOKS

Language Arts: Using *Pearson Ready Gen Grade 4* Students will practice their reading comprehension while reading a variety of fiction and nonfiction texts. Students will also fine tune their grammar, and writing skills each day through interactive activities.

Math: Using *Sadlier Math* we will be learning Place Value, Addition, Subtraction, Multiply by One Digit Numbers, Multiply by Two Digit Numbers, Divide by One - Digit Numbers, Factors and Multiples, Fractions, Decimals, Measurement, Lines, Angles, and Polygons.

Social Studies: Using *TCI Social Studies Alive* and students will be engaged in learning about Regions of our Country

Science: *Nancy Larson Science Grade 4* presents a unique hands on Science experience for students. We will begin the year as Biologist before moving into Botany, Zoology, Ecosystems, and Physics.
