Principal's Report

- Enrollment for 2022-2023 is looking good. Here are numbers currently enrolled:
 - PreK (3's) - 26
 - PreK (4s) - 42 (this means we may need to add a third 4-year-old class)
 - Kindergarten - 22
 - First grade - 33 (will need two classrooms next year)
 - Second grade - 21
 - Third grade - 22
 - Fourth grade - 21
 - Fifth grade - 14
 - Sixth grade - 13
 - Seventh grade - 14
 - Eighth grade - 20

- Plans continue to be developed to turn ½ of the library into a classroom for 1st grade next year.

- Open House was a success. Parents were impressed with students who were giving tours along with the adults. There was a good turn out. Families who visited had many positive comments regarding their visits.

- Star 360 testing will be beginning soon.

- The possibility of adding air conditioning to the gym at Guardian Angels is being explored. This summer, there are plans to have robotics camp, Vacation Bible School and a 3rd/4th grade basketball camp held in the gym.

- The school play, Moana Jr, raised \$1,000 in donations collected at the door. This is more than we would be likely to raise if we sold tickets for admission.

New Business

- SAC and GAP will be working together to coordinate representation from Guardian Angels for the 4th of July parade in Clawson. Cristin Joy will be reaching out to the parade committee to find out what we need to know.

Future Business

- The SAC sponsored Trivia Night is scheduled to be held on Saturday, May 21st at 7:00. Let's challenge the teachers who are the reigning champions! Plan to join us.
