- 1. Call to order (Francesca): 7:02 PM
- 2. Opening prayer
- 3. Introductions (Francesca)
- 4. Knights of Columbus (Terry Clayton)
  - a. Terry provided a background of Knights of Columbus and examples of what the Clawson Knights of Columbus #4188 do for the community including raising \$12K for autism with their Lenten fish fry dinners, quarterly blood drives, assistance to schools like Guardian Angels, etc. They are looking for members to join and recently had a few new members from GA. - 5. Principal's Report (Mr.Turk)
  - a. Francesca provided the update Mr. Turk sent as he was not able to join the meeting.
    - i. Reenrollment update: Preschool is good, as always. K-8<sup>th</sup> is at 254 which is the highest in ten years. We will have two (2) kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> grade, and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classrooms. We will need to purchase additional textbooks, tablets, chrome books, and possibly furniture.
    - Playground update: The playground upgrade has been approved by the family donating the funds. We hope to have everything installed in August.



- iii. Follow up question: GAP meeting attendees have a follow up for Mr. Turk to know what the threshold (student count for the grade) to split a class/add an additional class.
- 6. Treasurer's Report (Stefanie)
  - a. We are off to a great start to the year financially. A few notes on fundraising:
    - i. We had the proceeds from Shirlee's Delights come in at \$210 which brings the total to \$768 for restaurant fundraiser revenue. This is over budget so great job!
    - ii. The auction hosted a Trivia Night this year which brought in over \$2,700, a great start to the auction fundraising.
    - iii. The Secret Santa shop expenses are still coming through but right now the net proceeds are just over \$4,000 which is \$2,800 over budget.
  - b. On the expenses and sponsored event side of the budget, a few notes:
    - i. The Field Trip expenses are coming in for this year. As of right now we are at \$1,424 of our \$9,000 budget.
    - ii. Mother/Son Bowling was a big success and will under budget at \$93 for the \$200 budget allocation.
    - iii. There was a \$1,600 expense for United Streaming Subscription for this year that was paid in February.
  - c. Net profit to-date is \$24,543
- 7. Event Committee Reports (Francesca)
  - Winter Family Bingo Night: Jan.26 (Rhonda): This was Rhonda's first time chairing this event which went well. There were 35 registrations for Bingo and about 112 people. They had pizza and prizes.
  - Mom/Son Event: Feb. 4 (Michelle/Holly): This was a fun event with pizza, a superhero theme and special guests and photos.
  - Daddy Daughter Dance: Mar.23 (Julie, Veronica, Kristen): On track for the event this Saturday with forms and money due to the school or parish office by 3/21. There will be a DJ and photobooth. Volunteer spots are filled so they are all set.



- Spring Mom2Mom Sale: April 13 (Michelle/Melissa): Right now they have
  65 tables and waiting for Mr. Turk to confirm the table count. They are set
  with volunteers all and academy students can volunteer as well.
- First Communion Reception: May 1 (Miriam): This celebration will be the Wednesday after First Communion in the gym. Each student can have two guests join the reception. They need 2 volunteers to help with set up. A reminder email will go out to 2<sup>nd</sup> grade families.
- Children in Bloom Auction: May 4 (Mitchell/Chris, Shadow: Lori)
  - Ticket sales went live on the website and physical invitations will go out this week.
  - We really need volunteer sign ups. An eblast went out and info has been posted on the GAP Facebook page and in the Keeping Connected. For volunteer spots, you don't have to commit to the entire night. Volunteer spots are available before, during, and after the event which only need a few hours of your time.
  - Sponsorships/donations: We recommend reaching out to your work or local businesses to see if they are willing to become a sponsor and receive recognition. Acquisitions are going well for silent and live auction items, but we can always use additional help.
  - This event is open to non-GA families as well so feel free to invite friends.
