- 4. Principal's Report (Mr. Turk)
 - a. There's a lot of end of the year activities, including field trips and a field day tomorrow (May 22nd) which will be fun. Enrollment is great with 260 students k-8, plus 73 students for pre-K. Largest number Mr. Turk has seen since being at GA. The school has ordered 30 replacement chromebooks and 25 new tablets. We have ordered flex space furniture for second grade. It's going to be a try-out and see how it will go next year. Behavior wise it's been a good year. We've asked a few families to leave but overall it's been good.
